

Tour to Oz (Ozaukee County, Wisconsin) Saturday, August 25, 2012

Join the Dairyland Tin Lizzies as we travel to Ozaukee County, Wisconsin. Morning stops include a snack break at Stoney Hill School, the birthplace of Flag Day, and a tour of the restored 1860 lighthouse station at Port Washington. We will visit the Port Washington Culver's restaurant for lunch. After lunch, we will tour Ozaukee County Pioneer Village. Our tour will start at the parking lot of Zion Lutheran Church, 6430 Hwy. D, Allenton, three miles north of Wisconsin Hwy. 33 and ½ mile east of U.S. Hwy. 41. Departure time is set for 9 a.m. We will return approximately 5 p.m.

Admission for the lighthouse is \$4.00 per adult. Admission for Pioneer Village is \$4.00 for seniors and students, \$6.00 for other adults. If you are trailering your Model T to the tour, there is plenty of room for parking your trailer and tow vehicle at the church parking lot.
